PROGRAM: **JOAN KEYSER** shared a delightful program about her career as “Food Stylist,” a highly-specialized job preparing food to be photographed for advertising and other publications. Working for clients such as Kodak, Wegmans and Constellation Brands, she generally gets the call from a customer, the graphic designer or the commercial photographer.

We were all amused to learn examples of her “tricks of the trade,” intended to make food look delicious and to keep it “fresh” over the length of the photo shoot. Careful use of products such as paraffin wax (to keep food from soaking into bread or tacos, for example), WD-40 lubricant (for that

appetizing steak “glisten”), gravy maker *Kitchen Bouquet* (spread over an only-partly-cooked turkey to give it the desired golden-roasted color)...and the judicious use of glycerin, dry ice, *Zap-a-Gap* glue...she has a van filled with products which she has learned may be needed for a “food shoot.”

Besides managing the food to produce the desired appearance, she herself prepares all of the food for each shoot. Our thanks to Joan Keyser for a truly interesting and entertaining program.
